2024 COVID-19 Guidance and Protocols

While we expect that national COVID-19 levels will remain low, COVID will still be a presence this summer. The best thing we can do to prevent a COVID case at Camp, getting anyone sick or forcing an early end to a girl's time at Camp, is for everyone to come to Camp COVID-free.

If anyone shows symptoms of COVID-19 during Camp or has direct exposure, COVID-19 testing will be used to screen for the virus. Any required testing may be billed to the camper's account as a medical expense.

Should your daughter test positive for COVID while at Camp, your daughter will be required to leave Camp. Campers may return to Camp 10 days later or arrange for an alternate session if available. If your daughter leaves Camp due to a positive COVID test, her tuition will be refunded on a prorated basis. Please contact the office with questions or for further information.

If anyone in your household tests positive for COVID within two weeks prior to your daughter coming to Camp, it is essential that you contact the Camp office for further guidance before coming to Camp.

One person carrying the virus into Camp could cause a Monterey summer to end for all of our girls. So, let's do all we can to keep this summer as safe and healthy as possible!

2024 COVID-19 Release

Camp Monterey has put in place preventative measures to reduce the spread of COVID-19; however, Camp Monterey **cannot guarantee that your child will not become infected with COVID-19**. Further, participation could increase her risk of contracting COVID-19.
